Special Telephonic Board Meeting of September 08, 2022

Pursuant to A.R.S. § 38-431.02, notice is hereby given to the members of the Board of Respiratory Care Examiners and to the general public that the Board of Respiratory Care Examiners will hold a special telephonic meeting open to the public on Thursday, **September 08, 2022, at 10AM. Members of the public or licensed community may attend utilizing the information above. The Board may vote to go into Executive Session for any matter on the agenda to obtain legal advice from counsel pursuant to A.R.S. § 38-431.03(A)(3). In addition, the Board may vote to go into Executive Session on agenda to consider or review records exempt by law from public inspection, including the receipt and discussion of information or testimony that is specifically required to be maintained as confidential by state or federal law pursuant to A.R.S. § 38-431.03 (A)(2). Executive Sessions will not be open to the public.

The Board may address the agenda items in any order within the timeframe indicated, and may carry over matters to a later time when necessary. The Board reserves the right to change the order of items on the agenda, except for matters set for a specific time.
